The innovative design by SYB, with three booklets folding out like a cross, allows the viewer to play with an endless compositions of images.

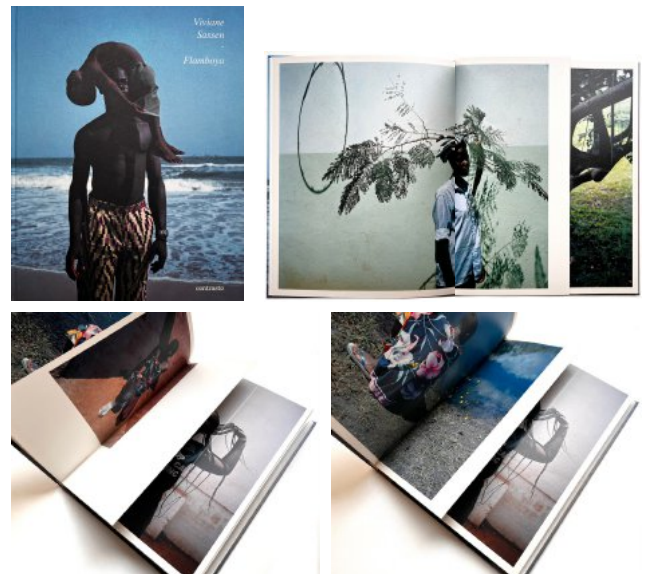

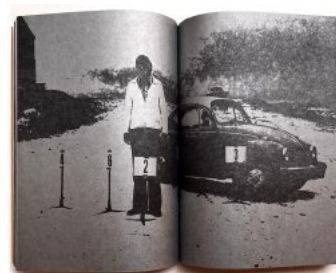
